## Connecting Ottawa can help connect you with services.

Do any of the following apply to your situation?

- “I was drinking at a party and blacked out. I think I was sexually assaulted.”
- “I was arrested for possessing an illegal drug. I am worried about how this will affect my job and access to my kids.”
- “When I was pulled over by the police, I refused to take a Breathalyzer test.”
- “I have a criminal record. It’s making it hard for me to get a job, rent an apartment and see my kids.”
- “I’m worried that my criminal record will affect my permanent residence status”
- “I am a sex worker and I advertise my services.”
- “My child is a prison inmate with a mental illness. I’m worried that he/she is not receiving the right health care.”
- “I’m the victim of a violent crime and I want to know if I’m entitled to compensation.”
- “I was arrested and was not given an interpreter, so I didn’t understand why I was being held and I was not told I had the right to talk to a lawyer before talking to police.”
- “I’m under 18 and have been charged with shoplifting.”
